**Requirements for the  
\$1,400 Winifred Collins Statewide Music Education Scholarship  
&  
\$1,400 Gertrude Seiberling Local Music Education Scholarship**

**For the statewide scholarship**, the applicant must be a United States citizen and the applicant must be a legal resident of Ohio, or the applicant's college must be located in Ohio.

**For the local scholarship**, the applicant must be a United States citizen and a legal resident of Medina, Portage, Stark, Summit or Wayne County, or the applicant's college must be located in one of these 5 counties.

**The following apply to both scholarships:**

1. The applicant must have attained at least junior status at the time of application and must be currently enrolled and seeking a degree/certification in Music Education at the undergraduate or graduate level.
2. The applicant must supply essays (typed and double spaced) on the following three topics:
  - A brief essay (up to 500 words) focusing on the applicant's motivation for choosing a career in music education and a statement of short-term and long-term goals, including specific plans for a career in teaching.
  - An essay outlining scholarships, honors, performances, activities and professional music organization memberships, plus other pertinent information and experiences.
  - General transcripts achieved in Music Education, a current photocopy of grades, and list of related subjects which will have been completed by the end of the current academic year.
3. The applicant must bring his/her instrument and be prepared to play from his/her performance category from standard repertoire. Please choose one from the performance repertoire requirements. Please see Performance Requirements for Scholarship Applicants.
4. The Music Education professor along with the applicant must sign the application.
5. Only the **first 10 applications** (according to postmark date within the acceptance period) can be accepted for Music Education. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure legibility of the postmark date.
6. **No person may win two years in succession or more than twice.**
7. A non-refundable application fee of \$35 payable to Tuesday Musical Association must accompany the application. Fees will be returned for applications that cannot be accepted or do not have the applicant's name on the check or on the memo line.
8. The application form, fee and all of the supplementary items identified above must be mailed to the scholarship chair as one packet, and must be clearly postmarked no earlier than January 8, 2012 and no later than February 11, 2012.
9. All applications must be approved by the scholarship committee.
10. Applicants must be interviewed by the judges on March 10, 2012 at The University of Akron, Guzzetta Hall.
11. Music Education Scholarship winners are invited to attend the Scholarship Winners Recital on May 20, 2012 at 2:00 p.m.
